As the third country in the world to legalize same-sex marriage back in 2005, it's no surprise that Spain is welcoming to the LGBT+ community. We'll be your hosts on this incredible trip to Barcelona and Sitges from May 12-18, 2022.

Thursday, May 12 – BARCELONA: Arrival and private transfer

Tuesday, May 17 – SITGES: spare time & gay beach + Wine Tasting and Group Dinner

DAY 1 / Thursday, May 12: BARCELONA

- Arrival to Barcelona -El Prat Airport (BCN) and private transfer to the hotel. Someone will be waiting for you for the transfer to Axel Hotel Barcelona, the most popular gay hotel in the city.

- Welcome and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to start exploring the city. We will also give you the Gourmet Pass with 2 lunches or dinners included at many popular restaurants in Barcelona plus a city transportation pass. We recommend saving this Gourmet Pass for two group dinners on Day 2 and Day 3, but you're welcome to use them before if you prefer to dine on your own, rather than with the group.



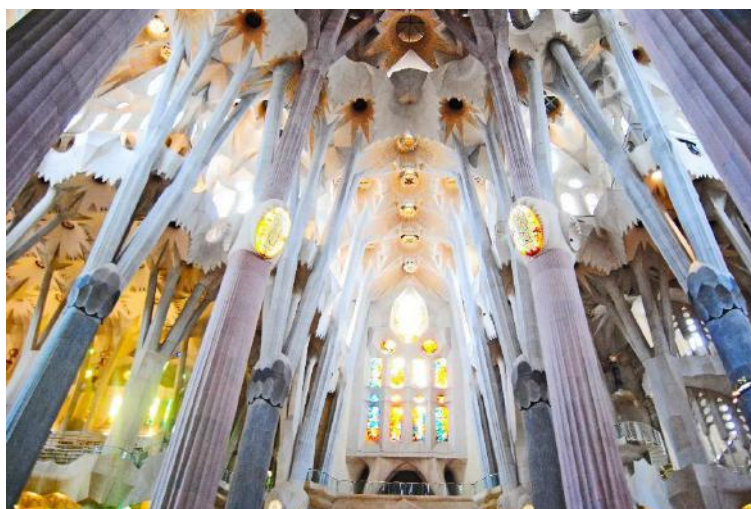
DAY 2 / Friday, May 13: BARCELONA

· 4pm – City Center and Sagrada Familia Tour (3h)

Barcelona is a city of culture with splendid architecture and historical buildings featuring the city's Catalan heritage. In this three-hour walking tour, we will explore the historic city center including Plaza Cataluña and La Rambla.

The tour continues at the Sagrada Familia – arguably the most famous landmark of Barcelona. Designed meticulously by the great architect Antoni Gaudí, this work of art has taken over 100 years to build and contains the finest architecture in the city.

During the tour we will talk about the city's gay history, lifestyle, and nightlife. We will make sure you have all the information to fully enjoy one of the most gay-friendly cities in the world!

DAY 3 / Saturday, May 14: BARCELONA

· 4pm – Modernism Gaudi Houses and Park Güell Tour (3h)

We will visit the exterior of the modernist buildings of Puig i Cadafalch, Domenech i Montaner and Gaudí, some of the architects behind impressive buildings like Casa Amatller, Casa Lleó i Morera, La Pedrera and Casa Batlló.

Then we will explore more magnificent work made by Antoni Gaudí: the beautiful Park Güell with stunning views of the city.

10pm - Eurovision Viewing Party at Axel Hotel Sky Bar

The Eurovision Song Contest has always been one of the most important annual events for much of the European LGBT+ community. Lucky for us, this year's song contest being held in Italy (last year's winner) just happens to take place during our group trip! So we're planning a viewing party for the finale at the Sky Bar by Axel in Barcelona. Let's find out 2022's winner together!



DAY 4 / Sunday, May 15: BARCELONA

· 7pm – Flamenco Show or Tapas Tour + Drag Queen Club

On this day you are able to choose between a Flamenco Show or a Tapas Tour. The Flamenco Show has been in the heart of Las Ramblas since 1970 at Tablao Cordobes. It is a small place inspired by the Nasrid art style, decorated under the direction of artisans and restaurateurs from the Patronato of La Alhambra.

During the Tapas Tour, you will have the opportunity to enjoy some of the best tapas bars in the neighborhoods of Eixample and Poblesec. You will taste different and exquisite Mediterranean – Catalan cuisine and haute cuisine tapas, always accompanied by the best wines and in a cozy atmosphere.

At night we will go to the famous drag club Believe to enjoy a drag queen show!



DAY 5 / Monday, May 16: SITGES

• 11am – Transfer to Sitges

After breakfast, pick up at the hotel in Barcelona for a private transfer to the hotel in Sitges. Just 40 minutes away from Barcelona, Sitges is one of the most famous gay towns in Spain. Its popularity goes back to the 80s, when the country's first gay nightclub was opened there. Picturesque streets, gay beaches, and an area full of clubs, restaurants and shops make this town one of the most popular gay destinations in the world. You'll have a free day to enjoy the beaches and the atmosphere in Sitges.

• 5pm – Sitges Tour

During this two-hour tour you will see many highlights including the Promenade which leads to the Church of San Bartolomé i Santa Tecla, where you will have one of the best views in town.



DAY 6 / Tuesday, May 17: SITGES

Morning

Explore the gay beaches or even one of the nude gay beaches.

· 5pm – Wine Tasting

Spain is known for its wines. Let's try a few while we discover the history behind them!

· 8pm – Group Dinner in the hotel sky bar



DAY 7 / Wednesday, May 18: SITGES

This is the departure day after 7 awesome days together. Check out of the hotel and if your flight allows, take the morning and afternoon to enjoy more of Sitges on your own. Transfers to the airport from the hotel will take place depending on your flight time.

PAYMENT & CANCELLATION POLICY

30% of the total trip price is due at the time of confirmation (deposit). The remaining 70% is due 20 days before the start date of the trip.

A 10% cancellation fee will apply if the cancellation occurs 45-30 days before departure.

A 25% cancellation fee will apply if the cancellation occurs 30-15 days before departure.

100% of expenses will apply if the cancellation occurs less than 15 days before departure (e.g. non-refundable).
